STUDENT ORIENTATION INFORMATION: Monday, August 19

FRESHMAN ORIENTATION: from 8:00am – 3:00pm in the Terry Center

Students will experience the traditions & customs of Jesuit Dallas while at the same becoming more familiar with the facility. Students will meet all of their teachers, participate in school liturgy, meet their Big Brothers & will be exposed to the multitude of clubs, sports, arts & extracurricular activities. Administrators & teachers will address the class, and upperclassmen will lead activities designed to help accelerate the acclimation process.

What to bring: **Nothing!** All supplies for the day are provided. Lunch is provided at no cost. We will not sell or distribute materials on this day. Please leave books, iPad and nametag at home.

To help with traffic flow due to recent construction, all freshmen should arrive no later than 7:30am on the first day. There will be personnel directing traffic. Drop off is at the Hall of Honors. After entering off of Inwood, cars are asked to pull forward to Hall of Honors (second set of doors) for smooth drop off and exit.
